

Descriptives! Yay!

Using SPSS

1. Save data file to computer from website.
2. Open SPSS.
3. Select *Open an existing data source*
 - a. Select your file (“390 Sample Data”) & OK
4. Select *Analyze*, then *Descriptive Statistics*, then *Frequencies*
5. Select each variable you want to include & move it (via arrow) to right side Variable(s) list
6. Push *Statistics*
 - a. under Central Tendency, check boxes for *Mean*, *Median*, and *Mode*
 - b. under Dispersion, check boxes for *Std. deviation*, *Variance*, *Range*, *Minimum*, *Maximum*, and *S.E. mean*
7. Push *Continue*
8. Push OK

Read your output

To find by men and women... (**Step 4** above) select *Crosstabs* instead of *Frequencies*. (**Step 5** above) Put desired variables in boxes (columns & rows). Push *Cells* then check *Row*, *Column*, and *Total*.
